

## Poster Presentation Guidelines (last updated: Oct 14, 2024)

### 1. Poster Preparation

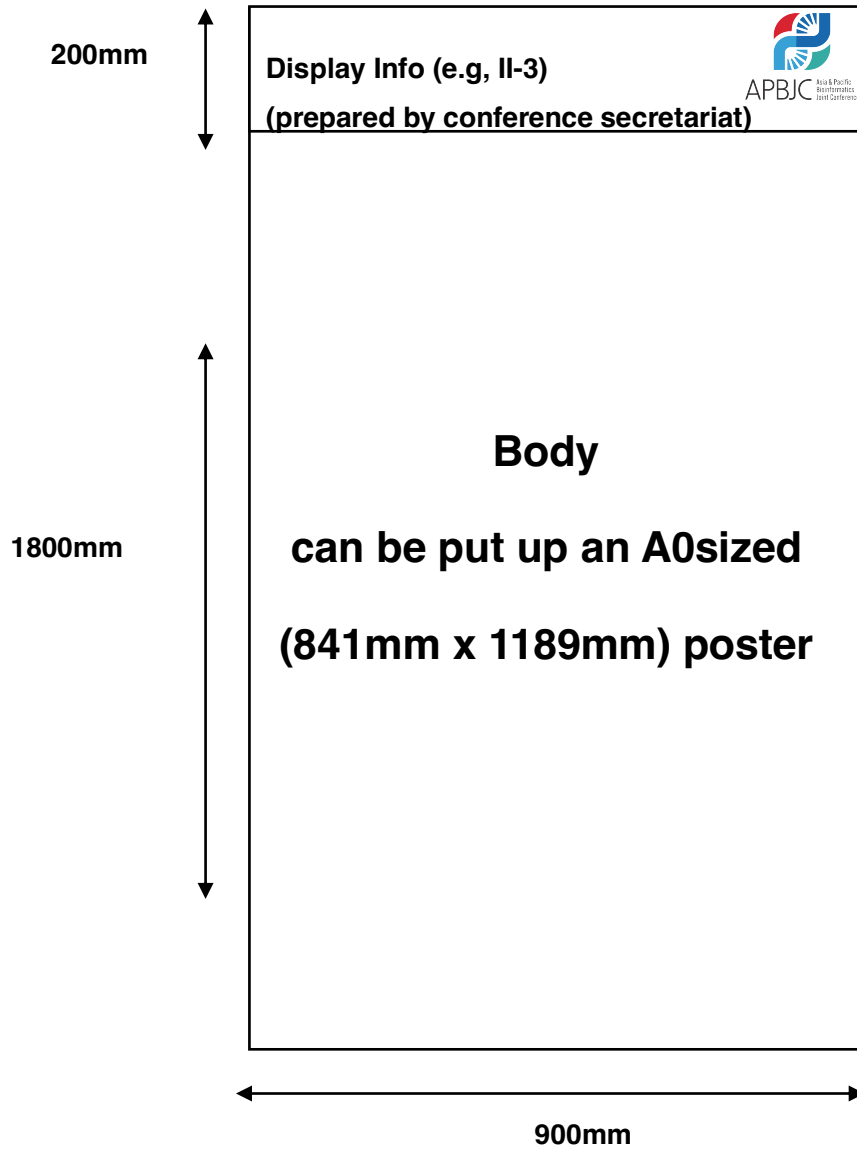


Figure 1: poster size

- Please prepare your poster according to the following panel size and Figure 1.
- The usable area of the poster panel is  
Height: 180 cm Width: 90 cm
- Please include your Display Information (explained below), Abstract Title, Author Name(s), and Affiliation(s) in the upper portion of the poster.
- Posters must be prepared in English.

### 2. Poster IDs and Display Place

- Please check the list of posters, which is accessible at [https://www.iscb.org/cms\\_addon/conferences/apbjc2024/posters.php](https://www.iscb.org/cms_addon/conferences/apbjc2024/posters.php)
- Each poster has two types of IDs (besides your original submission ID to EasyChair): Topic category and Display Information.
- All posters are classified into one of the topics A, B, ..., Z, AA, ..., and DD. The posters in the same category are displayed together.

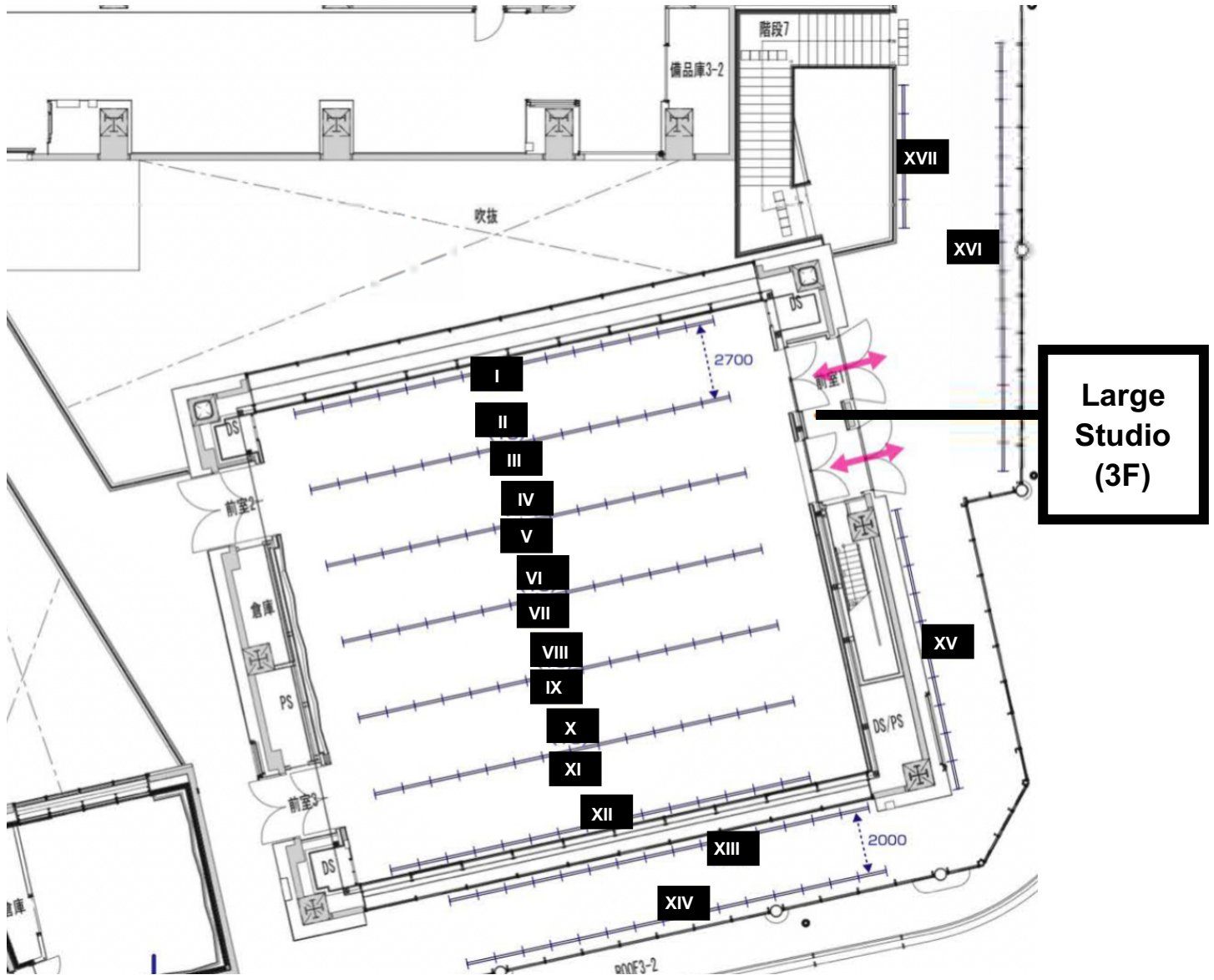


Figure 2: poster session layout

- The Display Information consists of the date, the panel place, and the position number in the panel. For example, 23-II-6 means that the poster must be displayed on October 23rd at the 6th place of panel II (designated as II-6 on the panel). For the positions of the panels in the venue, see Figure 2 below.
- The position number in the Display Information is used for your (face-to-face) presentation. Posters with odd numbers should be presented from 16:20 to 17:10, while those with even numbers from 17:10 to 18:00 on the 23rd; with odd numbers from 17:30 to 18:20, while with even numbers from 18:20 to 19:10 on the 24th.

### 3. Presentations

- Place your poster on the panel indicated by your Display Information within the designated set-up time (ca. 9:00-10:00 AM for each day).

Removal will take place at the designated removal time (18:00-18:15 on the 23rd; 19:10-19:25 on the 24th).

- You will find a magnet for placing your poster on your designated panel. Please do not use glue or tape.
- The Secretariat will discard all posters remaining after the removal time.
- The organizer and secretariat will not be held liable for any theft, loss, or damage of posters.

- Please refer to the Submission Confirmation email from ISCB for information on uploading the PDF and/or mp4 file.
- **PDF/Video upload due: 8th October 2024**
